Dr. E. William Bean is Director of the Centre for the Study of Biblical Research and a U.S.A. Advisory Board member of the “Dead Sea Scrolls Foundation.” Dr. Bean authored the book, “New Treasurers: A Hebraic Perspective to New Testament Teachings” and, writes for two periodicals,



“Restore” and, “Illustrated Bible Life.” In addition he has written introductions for “EKS Publishing Company” and “Meet the Rabbis,” authored by Dr. Brad Young. In addition he has served as a

member for the “International Synoptic Society.”

Dr. Bean had an astonishing experience in 1988 when he met the shepherd who

discovered the scrolls. Later the shepherd was taken back to the cave area. The video is a component of his Power-Point presentation.

Dr. Bean has sat under the teachings of scholars in Jerusalem. His own teachings exhibit similarities between the Sectarian Scrolls and the New Testament. This includes the words of Jesus and John, including the Synoptic Gospels.

The dualism of John (the Apostle); the “Odes of Solomon”; and, “The Community Rule,” all articulate dualism expressed by James Charlesworth in his book, “Jesus and the Dead Sea Scrolls.”

Dr. Bean is adept to studying the discoveries recently found in Israel. He

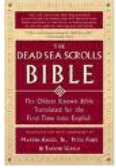


brings with him the replica of the “Scroll of Isaiah” that will be on display at the church. The sister replica has replaced the original at the “Shrine of the Book” in Jerusalem. The original is

now in a controlled environment and

unavailable for display. The scroll predates Jesus by 137 years.

The Dead Sea Scrolls Bible presents all 220 of the Dead Sea biblical scrolls, arranged to be read in canonical order. It is the Oldest English Version (translated from Hebrew) in the world. It can be purchased from amazon.com (www.amazon.com).
